





### Paper Run 2 by Guy Purple



Normal Sudoku rules apply (every row, column and three-by-three box contains the digits 1-9 once each).

You must draw a single, continuous line in the grid, such that:

1. The line moves from cell to cell vertically or horizontally.

2. The line never overlaps or crosses itself, nor branches or forms a loop. Therefore it has precisely two ends.

3. The box borders cut the line into segments so that the sum of the digits on each segment is equal. 4. The line passes through each blue circle, and the digit in a circle indicates the number of cells visited by the line in that box.

Cells highlighted in pink do not contain high digits (789). Cells separated by a pink X have a difference equal to the number of such cells not visited by the line.
